We are also a branded learning centre with ILA/Skills Development Scotland. Throughout the courses, you will be continually assessed as to competency and understanding and there is an exam and case studies to be completed after the course.

Three most common questions asked:

Can I learn it one/two days??? – YES! My aim is to keep group classes small with a limit of 4 students attending and we also offer 1-1 courses where you can either bring your own model or one can be supplied * please note on a 1-1 course you do not receive a treatment, but do get more practice time, this can help you maximise your training and costing just a little more than a group course!

When do I get my certificate??? - On the day you will receive a certificate of attendance with full diploma being given upon receipt of exam and case studies which are completed at home. In the rare case where I may decide that a student needs further training, the certificate will be held back and the student will be offered a place on the next course, free of charge. It would be irresponsible of me to issue certificates if I feel further training is needed.

What about after the course if I need help??? - after attending a course **you are expected** to put in the required practice, **if you do so**, you will have access to email, telephone or in person support for as long as you need it, be it 6 months or a year down the line! Caring about how you cope after a course is of paramount concern so never hold back when you need help, just ask!

Attended Courses

Group or 1-1? - A group course will have a maximum of 4 students attending. 1-1's have a maximum of 1 student with own model whereby the student does not receive the treatment or it can be 2 students only – this is so that each student has someone to work on and they give each other support, give much better feedback and ask more questions, you get a lot less from a model. Class times are generally from 9.30-15.00pm

Distant Learning Courses

We now have a growing list of courses which you can learn at home. These are with The Guild through their GTI (Guild Training International) and DT Therapy School.

Some have a practical attendance for 1 day for assessment, where you come to DT and get assessed on the movements, techniques etc that you have been learning. All are accredited with the guild and carry cpd points. Information is available for each one, simply email us and we will send it off to you. Please see previous page for courses available.

Booking, Deposits:

If a non ILA funded course is booked, then a **Non refundable deposit** of £65 is required to secure your space, payable by bacs, over the phone, cheque, cash or online via the link on our website with your credit/debit card or via an invoice. The remaining balance being payable 2 weeks prior to course commencement,

ILA funded: **See below** - All courses can be funded using ILA. The non refundable deposit is included in the ILA funds but if you cancel the course, you will liable for the required deposit as ILA will not fund deposits if the course is not taken..

ILA Funding:

What happens once I book?

Once deposit/ILA confirmation is received, you will be emailed your confirmation details which contains information on terms & conditions of your booking, Contra Indications, how to get here, what to wear, cancellation etc. Reading your confirmation details is part of your contract of booking a space. Please check these carefully and notify me of any errors.

You will also be emailed at the same time, your Anatomy Reference Manual, if required for your course, and a pre-course workbook. Again reading them is part of your contract of booking a space on the course.

There an option available to purchase a bound colour copy of the Anatomy Ref Manual for only £5 or you can purchase a bound copy of the very informative Injuries and Ailments manual – a great reference tool for all clients. The cost again is only £6

Payment of balances

All outstanding balances must be paid before course commences, normally 14 days before course date,.

Cancellations

All cancellations and date changes incur a £40 admin fee. Where there is a balance outstanding, any cancellation within 2 weeks of the course or a not showing up on the day, an invoice for the balance plus any admin fees applicable will be sent – please see terms and conditions

Induction Pack

You are given an induction pack on the day of your course, which will include an attendance certificate, insurance information, course manual, guidance sheets etc.

After Course Work

Every course does have an exam to be completed at home after the course, it gets returned in 7 working days. It is part of your overall coursework and goes towards your diploma award.

Each course also has case studies to be completed and the number of case studies to be completed varies dependant on the course you complete, either 12 or 18 sessions..

The case studies and exam forms are emailed to you in adobe pdf format and can be completed on your computer and returned via email, or can be printed out and sent in the post. Please note your version of adobe reader may need updating if it fails to open.

Once these are completed you will be sent your full diploma, this will be your qualification date..

Dress requirements for the day:

Uniforms, what to wear – No uniform is required for your course, please wear loose fitting/ comfortable clothes (no jeans or tight clothing). Courses with specific dress requirements:

- **IHM** – Females - please wear a vest type top that has straps can go under the arms
- **TFM** - loose trousers – NO JEANS or SKIRTS
- **THM** – short sleeved top
- **SPORTS, HANDSFREE, EBM**, - shorts are preferable for male students but recommend all students to wear lighter clothing/ shorts as it is very warm work, especially in the summer.
- **Nails:** please ensure your nails are trimmed short, no catches etc
