Course Information: The GTi Ear Candling course covers how to give a full ear candle treatment. It covers the history, technique and aftercare of the treatment. The course also covers reception and consultation, and contra-indications to treatment. The course includes detailed technique modules which show you how to carry out an ear candle treatment.

The course is beautifully written and accompanied by images, diagrams and a voiceover to give you the best possible learning experience.

The course includes online theory as well as a practical training session at a location of your choice, designed to give you the confidence and ability to offer a full ear candle treatment.

The candles work using the process of convection. The burning of the candle helps to draw softer waxes and toxins from the ear. Some of these are then oxidised or turned into vapours and burnt. The warm air from the burning



candle passes into the ear canal before being gently drawn back up to the top of the candle in a chimney effect. The warm air containing the herbal extract vapours from the candle helps to soothe and invigorate the ear.
